Footnotes: 1- Some of MTC's regional policies regarding transit require a role by the CMA, which is TAM. These are usually funding policies, such as Population Share STA, which is assigned to the CMA.

2- The Measure A Expenditure Plan requires TAM to approve the Marin County Transit District's Short Range Transit Plan ; this was done for the first SRTP by TAM in June 2006; subsequent SRTP's will be app

3- While TAM does not approve the MCTD Service Plan, TAM has a role in making sure the Service Plan reflects transit investment priorities in both the Expenditure Plan and SRTP

4- As with any funds managed by TAM as the CMA, there may be a TAM role in overseeing the project or program

5- Caltrans is expected to coordinate with the local jurisdiction when planning/ performing work at a local interchange; the locals should notify TAM of activity & may choose to involve TAM in coord. with Caltrans

6- While the local juris. is expected to develop & implement their own approved scope/cost/schedule on a local project, TAM to oversee IF the project funds come with a CMA/ Sales Tax Authority oversight role
