Highway 101 serves as the 'Main Street' for Marin County, connecting our local communities for work, school, services and recreation. Highway 101 is also a regional connection serving as a multi-modal system for carpools, regional transit services, auto trips and trucking, moving approximately 200,000 vehicles per day. efficient, TAM works with its partner agencies to support a number of highway improvements in Marin County. Projects for Highway 101, whether under construction, being designed, or being planned, are developed to work as an integrated system to address our mobility needs and facilitate the movement of our residents, workforce and visitors.
