Re: <u>Closed Session – Labor Negotiations [GC section 54957.6]</u>

**Dear Commissioners:** 

I request that you conduct a closed session during your regular meeting on January 24, 2019 to discuss the following matter: (1) Salaries, compensation and fringe benefits to represented and unrepresented employees. In my opinion, public discussion of this matter would prejudice your position.

The specific reasons and the legal authority for the closed session are: Government Code section 54957.6(a). A legislative body of a local agency may hold closed sessions with the local agency's designated representatives regarding the salaries, salary schedules, or compensation paid in the form of fringe benefits of its represented and unrepresented employees.

It should be noted that Government Code section 54954.5 requires that the Closed Session item be posted on the TAM agenda. Government Code section 54954.5 recommends that the posted agenda item description should include the name of the Agency Negotiator and the specific title of the unrepresented employee who is the subject of the negotiations as set forth below.
