RECOMMENDATION

Receive the update from the Safe Routes to Schools consultant team. No action is required.

BACKGROUND

The Marin County Safe Routes to Schools Program is nationally recognized as a leading transportation educational program, currently operating at private and public schools across the entire County. TAM took over management and funding of the existing program after passage of the original transportation sales tax in 2004. The program serves students from elementary school through high school and has been responsible for significant congestion relief in and around schools.

DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS

The current team is led by the prime consultant Parisi Transportation Consultants (PTC). PTC is currently in the second year of a three-year contract. PTC staff will outline accomplishments since the inception of the current contract. In addition to the educational programs, PTC studies and creates Travel Plans and Maps.
