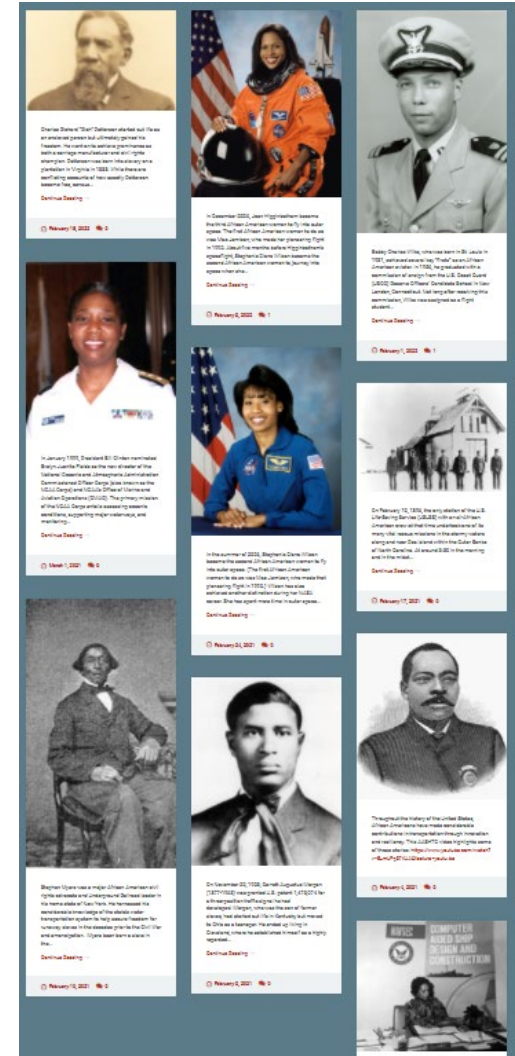

Ways to Celebrate Black History Month

- Throughout February, Marin County Free Library is highlighting special events and activities to create awareness and appreciation through books, films, art, public discussions, and other programming.
- American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials created a video presenting the contributions of African Americans to transportation throughout history. The video can be found on MTC's Bay Link transportation blog.



West Marin SR2S Task Force Created

- A new Safe Routes to Schools Task Force was created for West Marin.
- First meeting, hosted on December 6, was attended by approximately 20 people including Supervisor Rodoni, the Principal of Lagunitas School, representatives from West Marin Elementary School, parents, agency staff and interested residents.
- Several infrastructure needs were identified including potential improvements for biking and walking to/from schools in West Marin.



Marin-Sonoma Narrows Opens New Section of NB Carpool Lane

- On December 2, Caltrans opened a new section of carpool lane on NB US 101 from Kastania Road to Corona Road in Petaluma
- Creates a continuous 30-mile stretch of northbound HOV lane on a three-lane freeway from the Sonoma-Marín County line to downtown Windsor
- Southbound section expected to open through Petaluma in late 2022.
- Marin County final segment, B7 project, update to be provided tonight

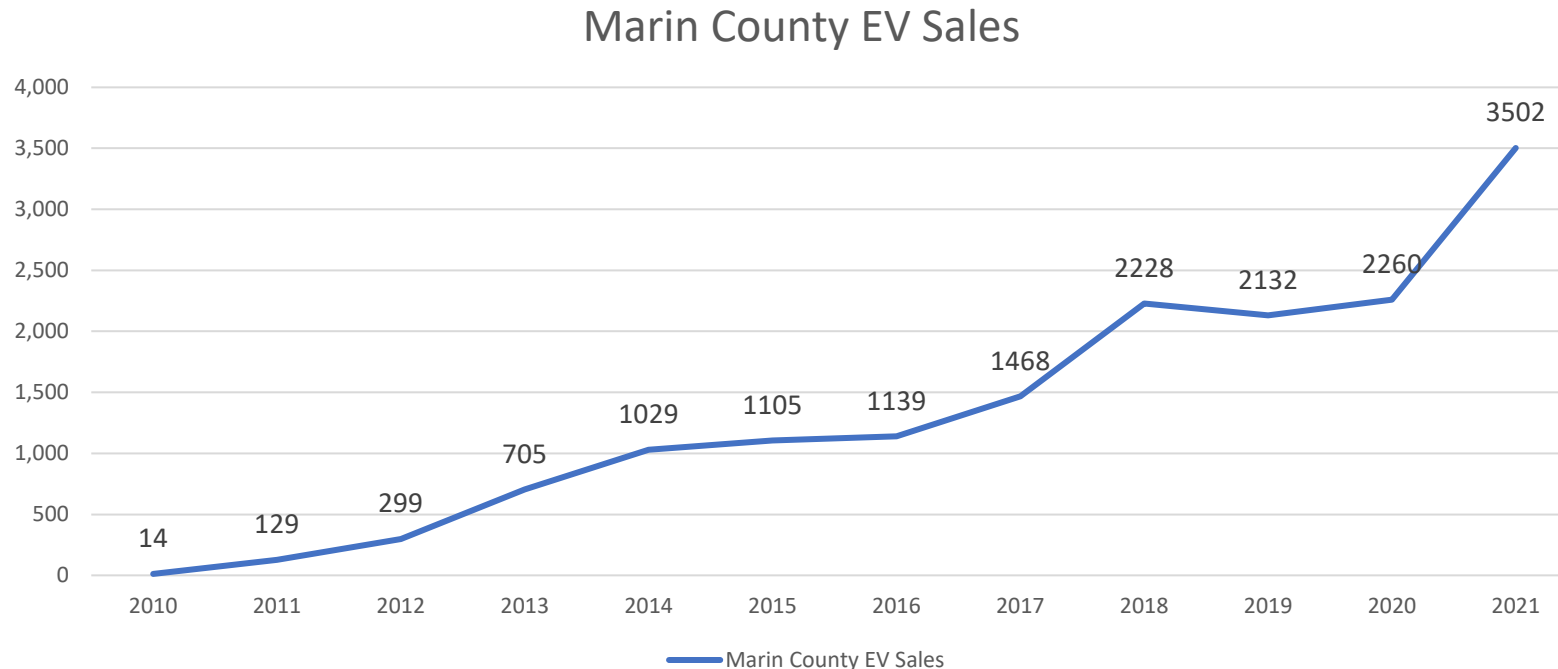
San Anselmo Hub Study

- The Town of San Anselmo is studying improvements to “The Hub,” a critical intersection connecting Sir Francis Drake Boulevard, Miracle Mile, and Center Boulevard
- A \$309,000 grant was awarded by TAM with a local match of \$41,000 from San Anselmo
- The study is looking at short, medium, and long-term solutions and will consider traffic, safety, and right-of-way



California Energy Commission Announces 2021 EV Sales Data

- The California Energy Commission released EV sales data for 2021
- 250,279 EVs were sold in the state in 2021, the highest total in the nation and an increase of 72% from the previous year.
- Marin County EV sales increased by 55% with 3,502 EV's sold in 2021.

Marin Water to Conduct Environmental Review on Pipeline

- Due to substantial rainfall and healthy reservoir levels, the Marin Water Board decided to develop the Richmond Bridge Water Pipeline project (titled the “Emergency Intertie Project”) using a traditional environmental review process
- Previously the project used an emergency process
- The formal environmental review process facilitates expanded engagement with project stakeholders
- Review process is expected to take a year or longer to complete
