East Blithedale Project – Sign-up to Receive Updates




Additional Transit Funding from the American Rescue Plan

- The U.S. DOT Federal Transit Administration (FTA) announced that it will award \$2.2 billion to 35 recipients in 18 states through the American Rescue Plan.
- The funds will help public transportation agencies pay for day-to-day operations as they continue to provide essential service and keep employees on the payroll.
- The allocation includes approximately

\$75 million for Golden Gate Transit

\$7.5 million for SMART




Community Project Funding – formerly known as Earmarks

Sir Francis Drake Blvd Gap Closure - Marin County was awarded \$700,000 for the bicycle/pedestrian network along Sir Francis Drake Blvd between Remillard Park in Larkspur and Andersen Drive in San Rafael.

This 0.7 mile segment is the last remaining gap in an otherwise continuous nonmotorized route between several of central Marin's most popular bike routes and the East Bay via the Richmond-San Rafael Bridge. The Federal funding will develop:

- The preferred project alternative
- environmental review, and
- preparation for construction

\$500,000 was also allocated to the Marine Mammal Field Response, Research and Rehabilitation team



SR 37 - Local and National Attention

- The State Route 37 project recently received national attention with an article highlighted in American Society of Civil Engineers magazine.
- TAM Board also received a thorough presentation by the project team on February 24 addressing the multiple near-term and long term-projects underway to address issues along the four-county corridor

Return to In-Person Meetings Subject to the Ralph M. Brown Act

- Currently, meetings held using provisions of AB361
- Upon expiration of the State of Emergency, provisions of AB 361 will no longer apply, and all Executive Committee, Citizens' Oversight Committee (COC), and Board Meetings will transition to a hybrid format.
- Upcoming meetings and expected locations:
 - Executive Committee Meeting – April 11 – TAM Office
 - Board of Commissioners Meeting – April 28 – Civic Center
 - No COC meeting expected in April, next meeting would be May 16 – TAM Office

Virtual Attendance & Remote Location Requirements

- At least a quorum of the members must participate from locations within the agency's jurisdiction (Marin County).
- Each teleconference location must be identified in the notice and agenda of the meeting.
- Agendas must be posted at each teleconference location.
- Once a location is noticed it must be made available for public participation for the duration of the meeting.
- If participating remotely, please submit location information to Board Clerk 12 days prior to meeting date for proper public notice.

Virtual Attendance & Remote Location Requirements (Cont.)

- Each location must be accessible to the public.
 - **Entry doors unlocked**
 - **ADA accessible**
 - Includes at a minimum, a paved path of travel from the parking location, grades not exceeding 8.3%, full standard width doorways, and furniture cleared to accommodate all users.
 - **Ability to watch and provide comment at your remote location**
 - Members of the public must be able to travel within the building to the meeting location without producing identification or signing a register.
