# Contracts/Procurement over \$100K

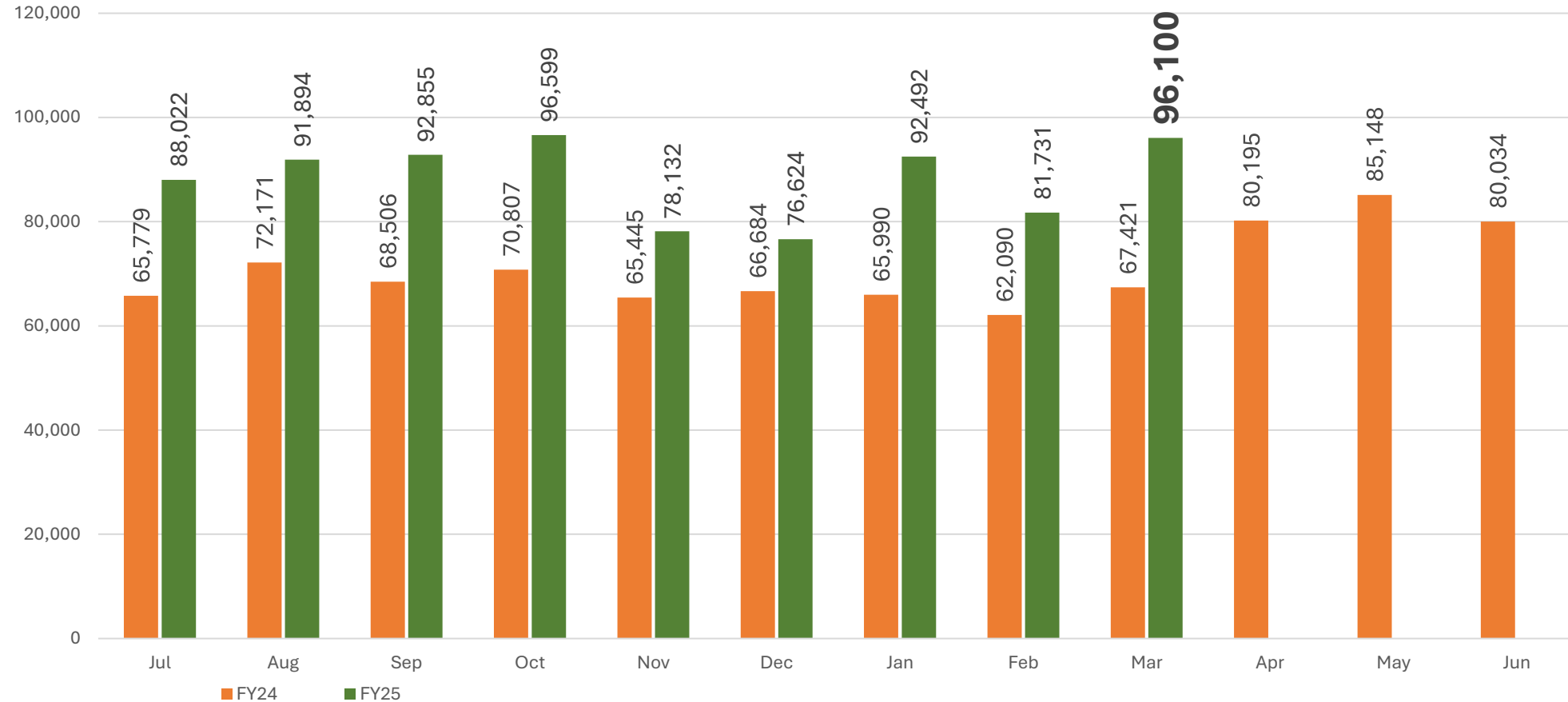
- Awarded Purchase Order SMT002680 with Elk Grove Dodge for two Dodge Ram 1500 4x4 Maintenance Trucks and one Dodge Ram 1500 4x2 Maintenance Truck
- Total Purchase Price \$137,300.25
- SMART leveraged the State of California Department of General Services Contract to take advantage of the economies of scale.

# SMART Ridership (Monthly)

March ridership = 96,100

- 43% higher than Mar 2024

**Served over 1 million riders in past 12 months!**



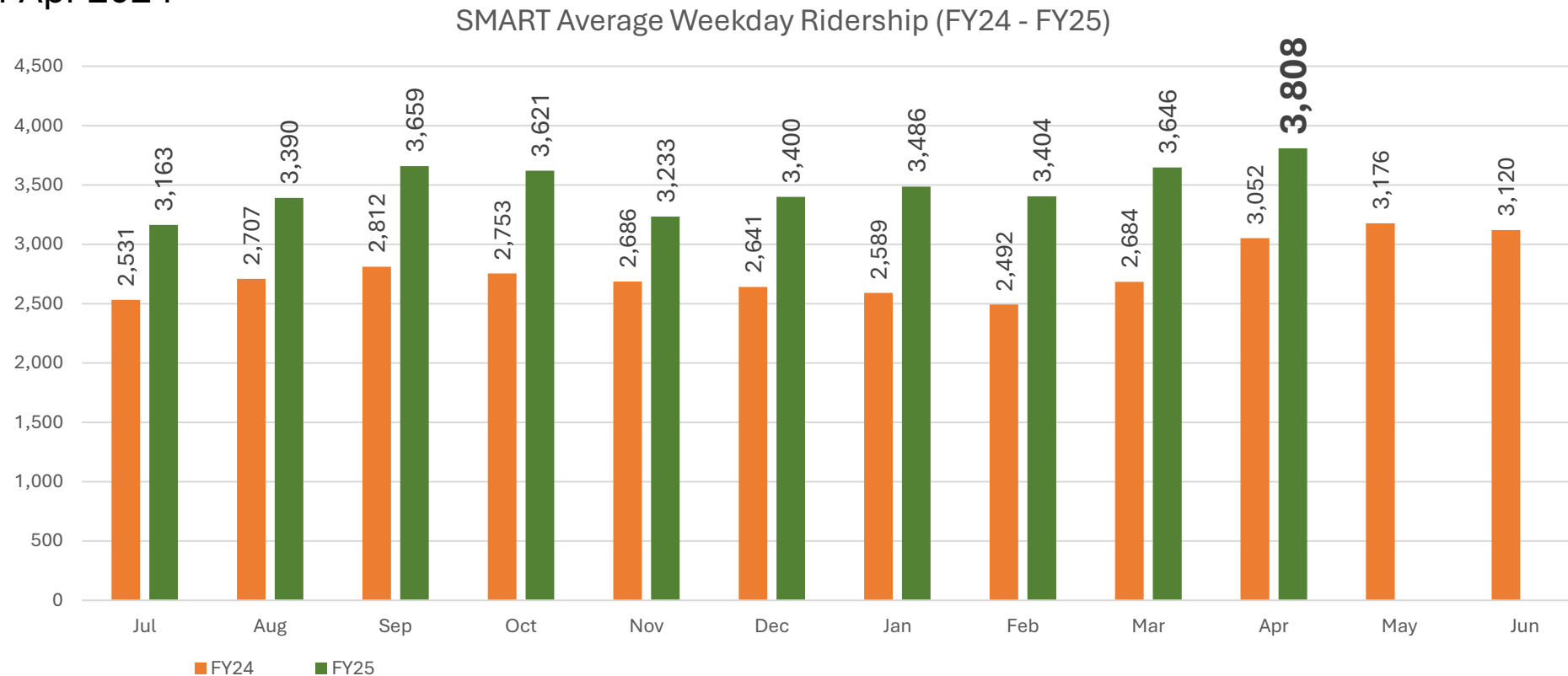
# Average Weekday Ridership

April Average Weekday ridership to date: 3,808

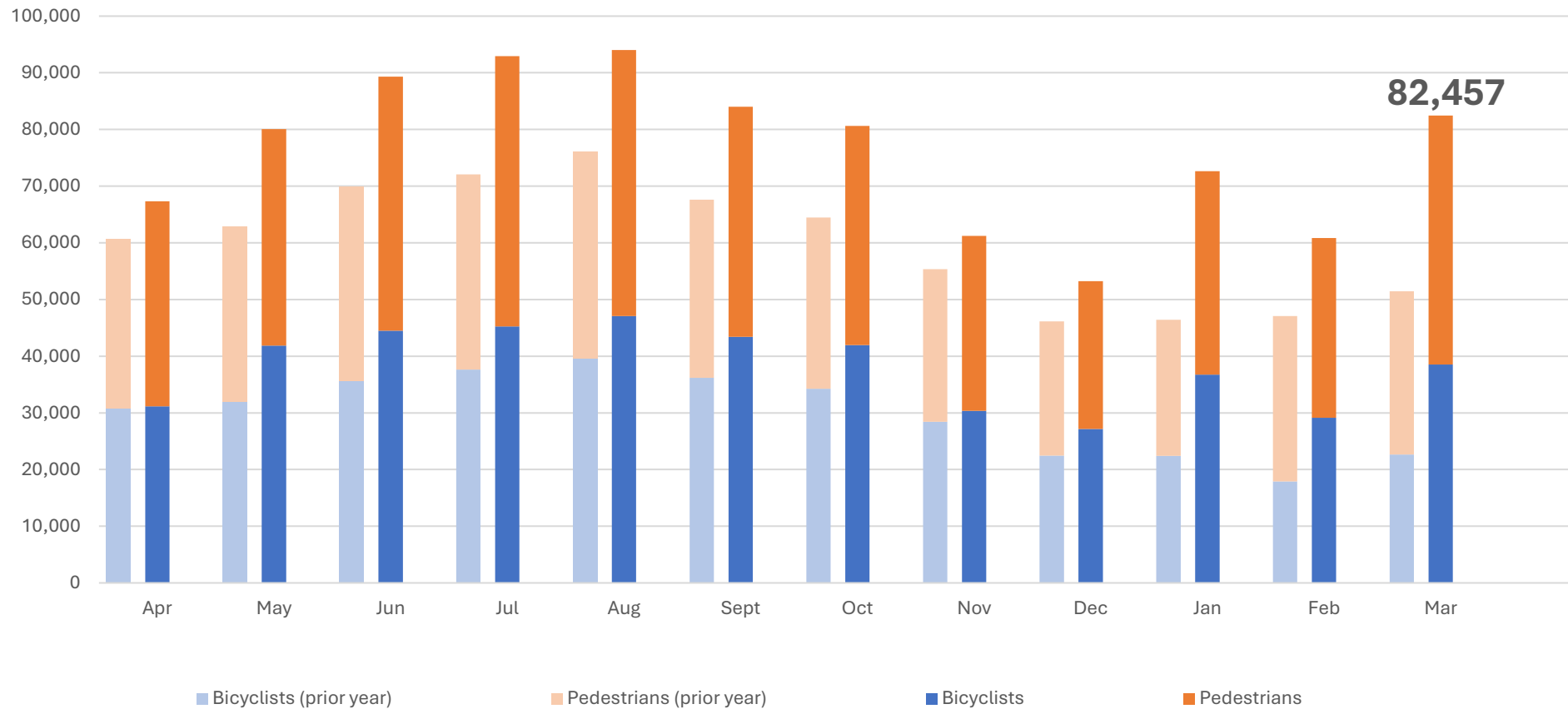
- 25% over Apr 2024

April 2023-March 2025

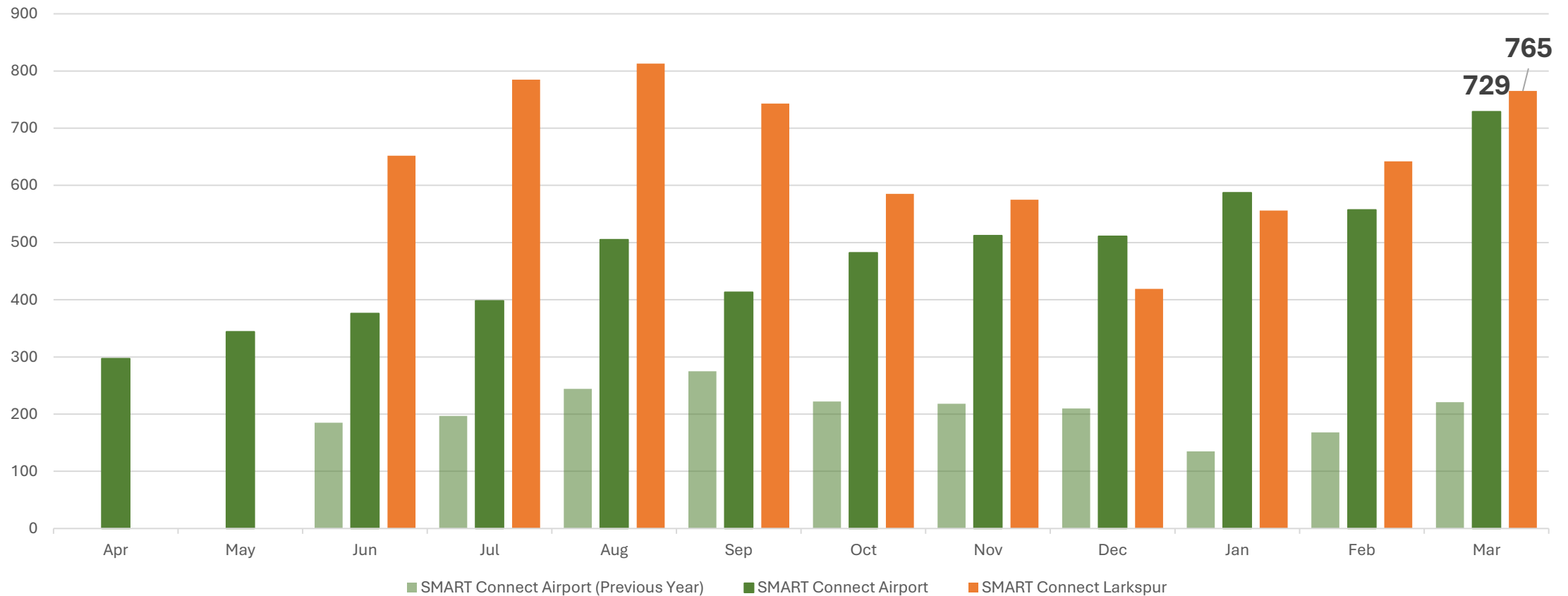
- 13 counters

# SMART Connect Ridership

- Connect Airport 152% increase over Mar 2024



# Connect Larkspur Expansion

- The Larkspur Connect shuttle expanded to 7 days per week starting Monday, April 7<sup>th</sup>
- Averaging over 45 riders/day first week of service
- New bench installed & new banner showing riders how to get to the Ferry terminal
- Expansion thanks to continued funding partnership between SMART, Golden Gate Transit, and Transportation Authority of Marin





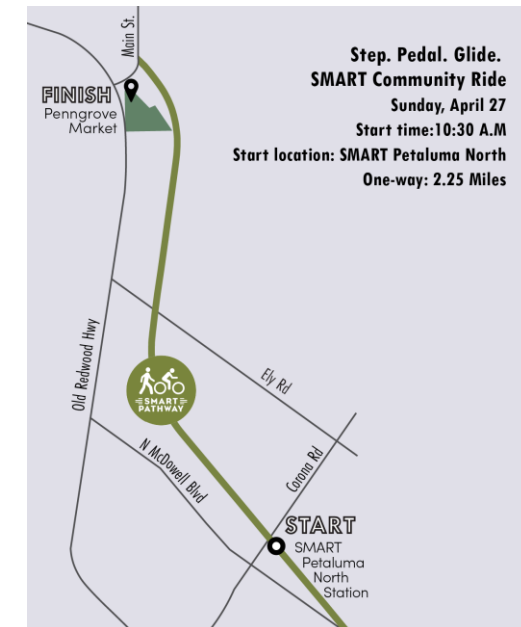
# Redwood Bikeshare Update

- Redwood bikeshare launched 6 months ago by SCTA & TAM
- Currently 262 bikes in field; 90% of total
- Bikeshare usage increasing, particularly at SMART Stations
- 555 trips taken on bikeshare in March
- Top 10 bikeshare rental hubs include Larkspur, Cotati, Petaluma Downtown, and Rohnert Park SMART Stations
- SMART continuing to partner with Redwood Bikeshare to promote the service

# Local Partnership Success

## Affordable Housing

- SMART requested to join Sonoma County and Santa Rosa to win State Affordable Housing Sustainable Communities funding in 2019
- SMART received \$5 million to construct Windsor extension and path from Joe Rodota to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street in Santa Rosa
- Tierra de Rosas & Casa Roseland received grants/loans for infrastructure and housing
- Infrastructure Under Construction
- 75 units affordable housing
