

August ridership = 125,407

- 27% higher than August 2024
- 5th straight month over 100K




Average Weekday Ridership

- 39% over August 2024


September Average Weekday ridership to date: 4,762

Passenger Miles Traveled (July)


- SMART carried 2.9 Million passenger miles in July

- 38% higher than August 2024




SMART Connect Ridership



- Born: May 21, 1935
- Spent entire life in Potter Valley
- Elected to Mendocino County Board of Supervisors in 1974
 - Served 20 Years
- Elected president of the California State Association of Counties in 1983
- Appointed to the Golden Gate Bridge and Transportation District in 1995
 - Served 24 years
- Chaired the Northwest Pacific Railroad Authority
- Became first Golden Gate District representative appointed to the SMART Board in 2004
- Served on the SMART Board 2004-2019
- Passed away July 13, 2005
