Questions received on TAM's Request for Proposals for Transportation Data Services, and TAM responses.

1. Does the response to Exhibit A (Additional Data Information Form) count against the 25-page limit? – **No.**
2. Most data and software solutions are provided pursuant to the terms of a contractor's standard license agreement, which may also contain terms from third party providers. These license terms often cover each party's ownership, use, and access rights in the data, as well as standard limitations of liability, warranty disclaimers, confidentiality obligations, and other terms. Several terms in the Standard Terms and Conditions would likely be in conflict with industry-standard licensing terms. Will TAM be willing to sign a separate license agreement governing each party's ownership, use, and access rights in the data? Alternatively, will TAM consider modifying terms in the Standard Terms and Conditions that may be in conflict with standard data licensing terms including but not limited to ownership, warranty, liability, and liquidated damages? – **As stated in the RFP, please list contract terms to which you take exception, and, as appropriate, provide proposed alternate wording.**
3. Additional Relevant Information (RFP Page 7). Do the two single-sided pages for Additional Information count towards the overall page count? – **No.**
4. Is it acceptable to export Exhibit A - Additional Information Form to an Excel Worksheet to complete? – **Yes.**
5. Does TAM have a specific format for the cost proposal? – **No.**
6. Exhibit A – Item 17. Is all the TAM required Transit data available via GTFS? – **Yes, all transit partners provide GTFS data.**
7. Exhibit A – Item 18. Does TAM or its partner agencies work with Operations partners like Swiftly? If so, who are the partners? – **MTC provides Swiftly data as requested, but this dataset is not directly available to local partners.**
8. Exhibit A – Item 38. Please confirm telework is work from home? – **Yes.**
9. Exhibit A – Item 39. Are you looking for public parking spaces - metered, unmetered? – **TAM is seeking any available data.**
10. Exhibit A – Item 39. Are you looking for private parking spaces paid unpaid? – **TAM is seeking any available data.**
11. Exhibit A – Item 39. Do you or your Agencies partner for parking services with companies like Park Mobile? If so, who are those partners? – **Parking Services companies in Marin County include Parkmobile in San Rafael, SMART, Larkspur Ferry, and Sausalito lots, any potentially other locations or companies operating in the county.**
